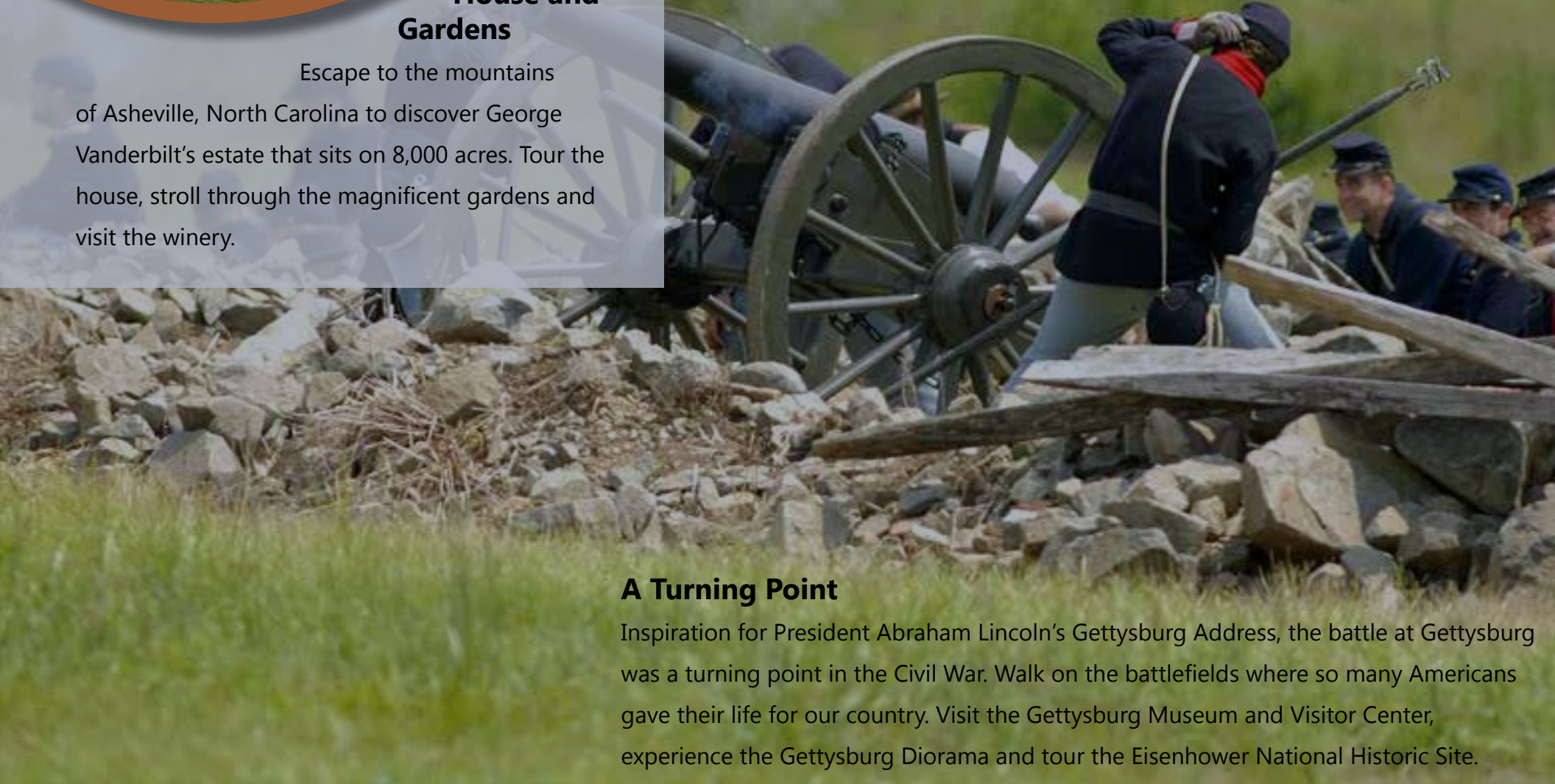


Biltmore House and Gardens
